## **Rosary Necklace**

Almost any bead will work for a rosary. You may want birthstones, favorite colors, antique beads or any beads which have a special significance for you. The finished rosary will have five sections of 10 beads, each separated by a spacer bead of a different size, shape or texture. The tri-loop center medallion will connect the five sections of 10 with the hanging crucifix "single" (*please see illustration on back*).

## Step 1:

Use round nose pliers to make a closed loop on one side of a section of wire. String on your bead, make another closed loop on the opposite side of your bead (see figure 1).

Link your beads together in the following pattern:

10 main beads, 1/2" section of chain, 1 spacer bead, 1/2" section of chain,


10 main beads, 1/2" section of chain, 1 spacer bead, 1/2" section of chain,

10 main beads, 1/2" section of chain, 1 spacer bead, 1/2" section of chain,

10 main beads, 1/2" section of chain, 1 spacer bead, 1/2" section of chain,

10 main beads.

In the rosary pictured, we've linked 10 of our 8mm bloodstone beads, added our chain, linked a 10mm red jasper bead and added another section of chain (see figure 2).



## Step 2:

Connect the completed sections together. Using approximately 3/4" of chain and a 4mm jumpring on either end, connect the linked beads to the rosary centerpiece.


## Step 3:

Create the crucifix single in the following pattern:

1 jumpring, 1/2" section of chain, 1 spacer bead, 1/2" section of chain, 3 main beads,

1/2" section of chain, 1 spacer bead, 1/2" section of chain, one jumpring (see figure 3).

Add the crucifix and you're done!




